CHECK LIST FOR PARENTS

- SPECIAL ELECTIVES FORMS:** Please return these to our office by **March 15th**.
- CAMPER DATA FORM:** Please return this to our office by **April 15th**.
- EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM:** Please return this to our office by **April 15th**.
- R&B TRUCKING:** Return the R&B Baggage Form directly to them by **April 15th**.
- TRAVEL FORM:** It must be returned no later than **March 31st**. Contact Plymouth travel early to book air travel , (800) 682-0135
- HEALTH HISTORY FORM:** Please make sure that it is completely filled out and signed, including your insurance/prescription information. **This must be returned to us no later than May 15th.**
- MEDICAL TRAVEL CARD:** Return no later than **May 15th**.
- MEDICAL FORM:** Mandatory for attendance. Should be completed by the camper's physician and returned to us prior to **May 15th, 2008**.
- KIDS MED PACKS:** For campers taking daily pill form medications other than vitamins. Enroll online (See attached letter)
- INSURANCE FORM:** Please make sure that this is completely filled out and signed. **Attach a copy of the prescription and medical insurance cards.** It must be returned no later than **April 30th**. (Form to follow)
- DEPARTURE DAY INSTRUCTIONS:** Your individual departure instructions will be sent by **June 5th**.
- PASSPORT:** Needed for all campers finishing grade **9** no later than **June 10th**.
A notarized letter is also required giving permission for a Winaukee representative to take your son out of the United States.
- CAMP CLOTHING:** Remember to **order early** to avoid last minute rush and delays.
- HOTEL AND MOTEL RESERVATIONS:** These reservations should have been made already. In the event that you still need a reservation, we suggest that you refer to the enclosed list.
- VISITING DAY:** Details will be sent to you in June. Consult this handbook for Visiting Day policies.
